Qualifications for installation:

- You must read and understand these instructions before beginning the installation.
- You must have sufficient experience to install the kit and test for proper operation.
- You must be able to place the heater in a continuing safe and normal operating condition.

Preparation:

Confirm loose or missing bolts in the following area, See Fig. 1:

- 6 bolts securing the outer barrel to the lower cross members. (A)
- 4 bolts securing the axle assembly to the frame. (B)
- 4 bolts securing the fuel tank strap to the frame, oil only. (B)
- 4 bolts securing the motor support plate. (C)
- 8 bolts securing the frame corner. (D)

Tools required:

- 1/2 in. combination wrench or
- 1/2 in socket
- Ratchet

Installation Instructions:

The following instructions will illustrate the proper installation of the fastening hardware.

NOTE: DO NOT use an impact driver to try to remove or install the bolt.

• If the bolt is missing, install a new bolt with the thread-locker.
• If the bolt is present, remove it from the rivet nut and install the provided thread-locker bolt.
• Tighten the bolts.
