Tools required:

- Cordless drill
- 1/4 in. Socket
- 5/8 Wrench
- Standard Screwdriver
- Needle Nose Plier

Qualifications for installation:

- You must be able to read and understand these instructions.
- You must be properly trained and have sufficient experience in servicing heaters and be capable of testing the heater for proper operation.

General Information:

- The following instructions provide information for the replacement of the Premier 40 burner assembly.
- · Read all instructions carefully before beginning installation.
- Allow the heater to cool down or in cold condition before starting the installation.
- · Tighten all screws securely.
- · Always leaks check any gas connection after installation with an approve gas leak detector. Tighten if necessary.

Preparation:

- Shut off the gas supply to the heater.
- Allow the heater to burn off the gas in the line.
- Unplug the heater from its electrical source.
- Disconnect the gas hose from the heater's hose adapter.





Preparation:

1. Lay the heater on its side and remove the four screws on each side of the case. See Fig. 1.




- 2. Careful tilt the heater back on its legs.
- Open and remove the burner end door from the heater by pressing the top pin upward to released the door. See Fig. 2.



- 4. Remove the case assembly from the heater base.
- 5. Disconnect the igniter cable, CSST compression nut, and hairpin. See Fig. 3.

NOTE: Save the hairpin to be used later. The orifice/ elbow assembly can be discarded.



- Remove the four screws securing the old burner assembly to the heat chamber. See Fig.3.
- 7. Remove and discard the old burner assembly.

Installation:

- Insert the replacement burner assembly to the heater chamber and secure it with the four previously removed screws.
- Insert the new provided orifice/elbow assembly to the orifice holder bracket on the burner assembly and secure it with the previously remove hairpin. See Fig. 4.
- Connect the CSST compression nut to the elbow. Taking caution not to cross thread the compression nut. Tighten securely.
- 4. Connect the ignition cable boot to the igniter.

 Ensure the boot snaps onto the igniter properly.
- 5. Install the case onto the heater and secure it with the previously removed eight screws.



Completion:

- 1. Reinstall the burner side door.
- 2. Connect the gas hose to the heater.
- 3. Slowly open the gas valves at the propane tank.
- 4. Connect the heater to its electrical supply.
- 5. Start the heater to ensure proper and check for gas leaks at the CSST connection. Tighten if necessary.
- 6. Close and lock the burner side door.
