

Tunnel Door Ratchet Instructions



1. After the cord has been threaded through the pulley (not provided) on the wall, pull the cord through the hole in the ratchet shaft. (fig. 1)



2. Tie a knot in the end of the cord so it will not slip through the hole. (fig. 2)



3. Pull the cord so the knot is flush against the ratchet shaft. (fig. 3)

4. Use a socket or wrench to turn the 5/8" nut in a clockwise direction until the cord is taut and no slack remains. (fig. 4)



5. Make sure the cord is centered when entering the ratchet from the wall to eliminate the chance of binding or rubbing against the ratchet assembly. (fig. 5)
