Tools required:

- Electric drill with 1/8 in. drill bit
- 1/4 in. nut driver

Initial Preparation:

1. Disconnect the heater from its electrical supply.

A. Installation instruction for kit 30161 / 30161A

1. Slide exhaust pipe onto heater exhaust stack.
2. Drill 4 - 1/8 in. holes evenly spaced around the exhaust stack. See Fig. 1.

3. Secure exhaust pipe with screws supplied in kit. See Fig. 2.

**C. Installation instruction for kit
30162 / 30162A**

1. Slide rain cap onto exhaust pipe. See. Fig. 3.

2. Secure rain cap with screws supplied in kit (space screws evening around the pipe). See Fig. 4.
