WARNING Tipping Hazard



- Heaters must be stacked on a solid, stable, level surface.
- Never stack on dirt or other soft surfaces.
- Never try to move stacked heaters.
- Remove gas supply hose and regulator prior to stacking.
- Never stack more than manufacture recommended.
- Never operate the heaters while they are stacked together.
- Do not lift the heater in any other locations than shown in these instructions.
- Failure to follow these warnings can result in serious injury or death.

Equipment Required:

- OSHA approved forklift, equipped with proper operator cage protection and capable of lifting a minimum of 650 Lbs.

- You must be able to read and fully understand these instructions.

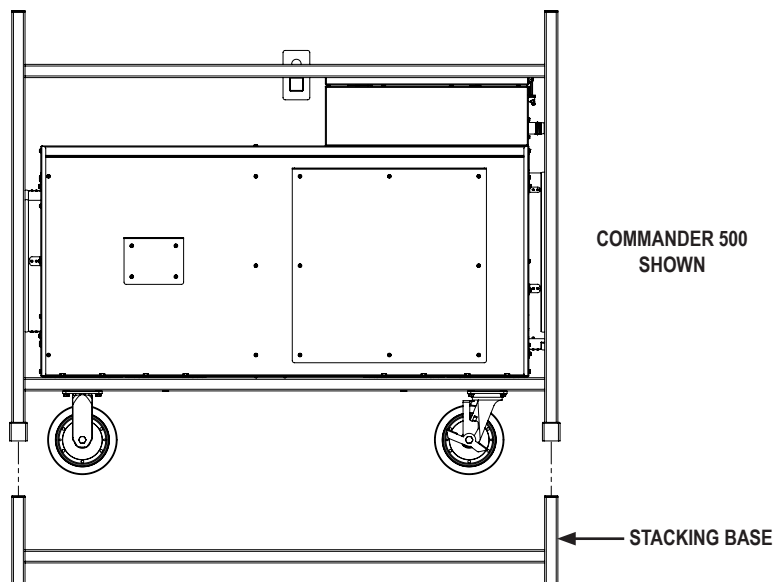
General Information:

- Read all instructions carefully before starting the installation.
- These instructions detail the proper use of the Commander heater stacking kit.
- The kit is designed to remove the weight of the top heaters from the wheels of the bottom heaters, preventing flat spots.
- Ensure the heaters are cool or at room temperature before stacking.

Instructions:

1. Position the stacking base and heaters as close to the storage area as possible.
2. Using a forklift, carefully lift the heater above the stacking base posts (see Fig. 1).

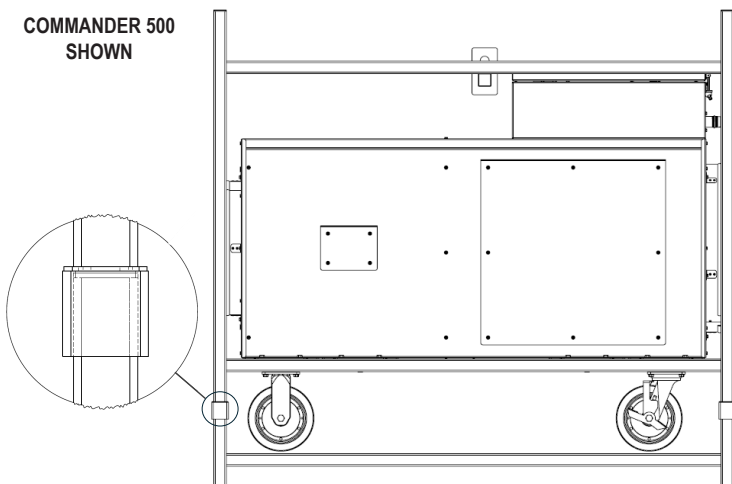

3. Lower the heater onto the stacking base, ensuring the stacking posts are fully inserted into the heater frame sockets (see Fig. 2).

4. If needed, stack an additional heater on top of the first, following the same procedure.

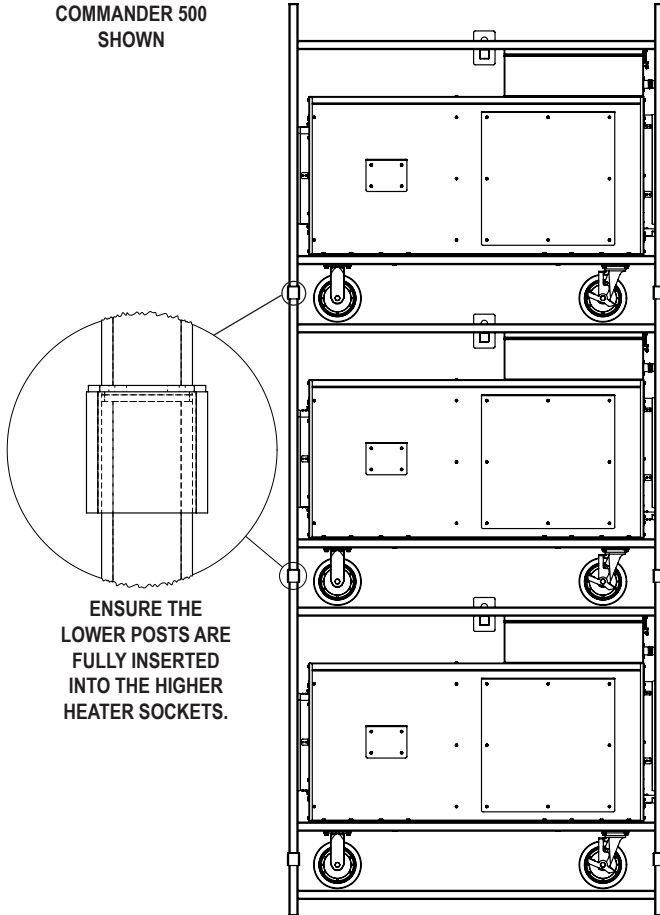
Maximum stack height:

Commander 500/1000: Up to 3 units high.

Commander 1500/2300: Up to 2 units high.
